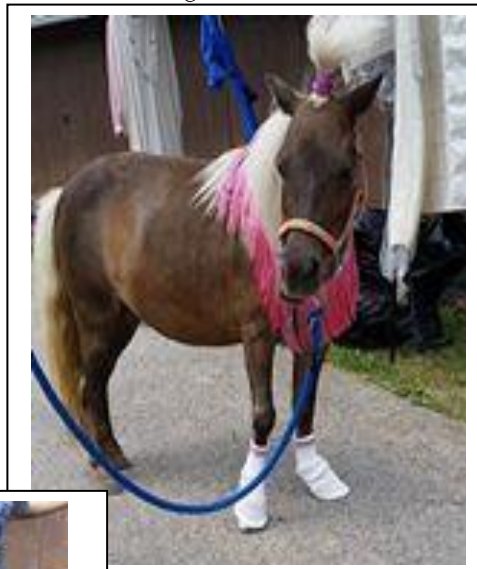

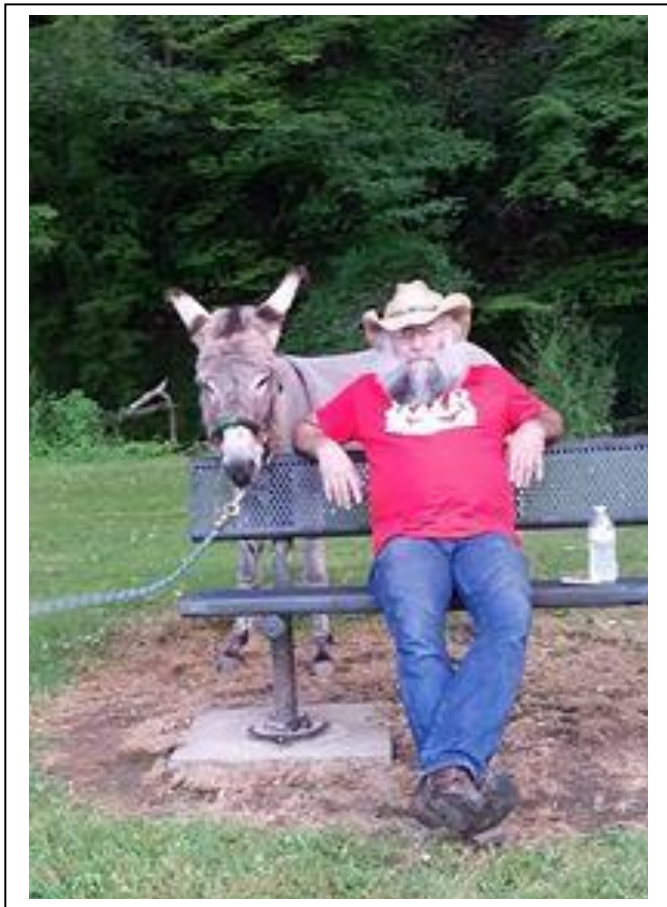
In June we hosted our first trail ride fundraiser with Chinese auction and pony rides:
